
Mobile Usage Today




Worldwide Smartphone Sales in MMs






Worldwide Smartphone Sales in MMs






PERCENT OF PC SHIPMENTS – DESKTOP vs. PORTABLE




RAMP-UP – MOBILE WEB vs. DESKTOP WEB







RAMP-UP – MOBILE WEB vs. DESKTOP WEB TOTAL






MOBILE WEB APPLE IMPACT

It took approximately 7 years for global sales of PCs to reach 1M units!






MOBILE WEB APPLE TABLET IMPACT






MOBILE WEB APPLE TABLET IMPACT – iPAD SALES



What is Cloud Computing and why is it relevant to our discussion today?

- Attractive, cost-efficient pricing models, limited up-front costs
- Reliability of Internet access
- Advanced and dependable security and privacy
- Web-hosted environment allows firms to focus on business, rather than IT management
- Firms need to do more with less resources
- Firms want to focus on what they do best



Anywhere, Anytime Access

- Remote access provides:
 - Staff retention with work/life balance solutions
 - Non-traditional options for "busy season" staffing
- Allows you to tap into industry specific expertise in different locations
- Supports mobile users in the field



Process Efficiencies & Increased Client Satisfaction

- 24/7 anytime/anywhere software access =
